



RADIUS Policy

Purpose

Remote Authentication Dial-In User Service (RADIUS) is an application that enables authentication, authorization and accounting data to a specified service. RADIUS accounting data is used to trace a user back to an IP in the event of an abuse complaint, subpoena, or as requested by a Member company. This policy is to define and set the retention for accounting messages to ensure databases stay maintainable.

Scope

This policy applies to any RADIUS systems used by Airstream, Airstream Members, or customers of Airstream Members.

Definitions

RADIUS accounting data: When a user attempts to authenticate or is authorized to a service, logging and metadata is recorded.

Policy

Retention

RADIUS accounting data will be kept for up to 3 years and then purged. Once the data is purged it will not be recoverable.
